BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On March 31, 2015, an application was filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., Kearney, Nebraska, seeking the removal of its restriction against point-to-point transportation in Lancaster County, and the removal of language restricting transportation originating within Lancaster County against groups of six (6) or less. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized and the HHS Designation is Yes.

Protests were timely filed by Papio Transport, through its attorney, Steve Mossman; by Servant Cab through its attorney, Jack Shultz; and by Transport Plus.

In order to process the application, the Commission held a planning conference in this matter on May 13, 2015, at 9:00 a.m. via telephone conference with the Applicant and counsel for the represented Protestants. The following persons were present at the conference: Commissioner Frank Landis; Andy Pollock, attorney for the Applicant; Steve Mossman, attorney for the protestants Papio Transport and Transport Plus; Jack Shultz, attorney for Servant Cab; and Mark Breiner, staff attorney.

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those

decisions and to provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket.

Any remaining pre-hearing issues that the parties would like to address should be brought before the Commission prior to hearing.


O R D E R
