BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 4, 2018, Camelot Transportation, Inc. ("Camelot" or "Applicant"), Kearney, filed an application seeking authority to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by removing a restriction that requires Applicant to use only passenger vans, handicapped equipped passenger cutaway vans, and SUVs in its provision of transportation services throughout the state of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 17, 2018. No protests were received; therefore, the application was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of Commission Rules of Procedure.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that the Application filed by Camelot Transportation, Incorporated to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be approved. The restrictive language regarding specific vehicles contained in Certificate B-1802 should be stricken and replaced with the following:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage in open class service between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized.

Camelot received its certificate of authority prior to the requirement that the authority to provide transportation for the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services ("HHS") be specifically noted on a passenger carrier certificate. The Commission notes that this Order does not amend Camelot's ability to provide such service for HHS.
