BY THE COMMISSION:

By Show Cause Order entered February 28, 2012, this Commission ordered R & M Transportation, Omaha, Nebraska, to demonstrate why its application should not be dismissed on or before April 17, 2012. A hearing on the matter was held on April 24, 2012, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. Mr. Rifaat Hassan, president of R & M Transportation, did not enter a personal appearance at the hearing. Mark Breiner appeared on behalf of the Commission staff.

According to testimony from Mr. Breiner, the Applicant filed for authority as a transporter of passengers in September of 2011. The application was protested. The Applicant was contacted by phone by Mr. Breiner. The Applicant requested time to determine how it wanted to proceed. When contact was attempted again, the phone number for the Applicant had been reassigned. On February 28, 2012, an Order to Show Cause was entered by the Commission, and Applicant was ordered to show cause on or before April 17, 2012, why its application should not be dismissed for failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission in not executing the application. Notice of the hearing on the Order to Show Cause was served by certified mail on the Applicant. The Applicant has not made any contact with the Commission or any member of Commission staff during this time period.

After being duly advised in the premises, the Commission finds that the Order to Show Cause should be sustained, and that Application No. B-1804 should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of R & M Transportation, in B-1804 shall be, and it is hereby dismissed.


