OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 4, 2011, TAA, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Kravek, LLC, dba Aquila Limo Service, in Certificate B-1758 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: The transportation of passengers and their baggage by limousine service between points in Sherman, Buffalo, Custer, Garfield, Hall, Howard, Loup, Blaine, Valley, Greeley, Hamilton, Kearney, Phelps, Adams, Webster, Clay, Chase, Dundy, Hayes, Hitchcock, Frontier, Red Willow, Furnas, Gosper, Dawson, Harlan Franklin, Nuckolls, Boone, Nance, and Merrick counties, and between points within said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Transportation in sedan, van and SUV style luxury limousine vehicles is authorized. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

In its application, applicant further requested that this Commission grant temporary approval to the applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of such request for temporary authority was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 10, 2011, pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 2003), section 75-319.

O R D E R



IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by TAA, LLC, will, and it is hereby, granted to the applicant for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. (Reissue 2003), section 75-311, and to the rules, regulations and requirements of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority and the operations thereunder shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal of extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.


