## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 13, 2012, TAA, LLC, Grand Island, seeks to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 9, 2012, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application B-1806 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the rules of procedure of the Commission.

Current ownership of the Applicant is as follows: Alan R. Usher, 33-1/3%, Todd M. Carpenter, 33-1/3%, and Andrew W. Meier, 33-1/3%. The proposed ownership is Alan R. Usher, 100% stockholder.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
- 2. The proposed acquisition of control will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The certificate issued in Application B-1806 is not dormant.
- 4. An order should be entered in Application B-1806 authorizing Alan R. Usher to acquire control of TAA, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska.
