OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 24, 2016, Bar Crawler, Omaha, seeks to cancel its certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1811 on June 11, 2012. The Commission granted Bar Crawler the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party between points in Omaha and Lincoln. The transportation of railroad crews and their baggage was not authorized, and the HHS designation was no.

Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 28, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.
