On or about March 6, 2013, the hearing officer entered an order granting a Motion to Compel filed by Casino Cab Company (Applicant) requiring Happy Cab Company, d/b/a Checker Cab Company, Happy Cab Company, and Yellow Cab Company; DonMark, Inc., d/b/a Cornhusker Cab Company; and Valor Transportation Company, d/b/a Safeway Cab Company (collectively, Protestants) to disclose financial statements from 2010 through 2012 subject to the March 5, 2013 protective order.
