OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on June 6, 2012, Teenie Weenie Buses, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as Applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1819. On August 7, 2014, Applicant's Form E insurance was cancelled.

As of August 26, 2014, Applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before September 2, 2014, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Teenie Weenie Buses, LLC, Omaha, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before September 2, 2014, and a hearing was set for September 9, 2014, at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
