OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 24, 2018, JH Transport, LLC, Lincoln, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1831 on May 8, 2013. The Commission granted JH Transport, LLC the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in Lancaster, Saunders, Seward, Gage, Saline, and Platte Counties on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 26, 2018. No protests were filed, therefore this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.
