OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 1, 2016, Point to Point Charters, LLC (Point to Point), Lincoln, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1841 on July 31, 2013. The Commission granted Point to Point the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad crews and their baggage was not authorized, and the HHS designation was no.

Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 4, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Point to Point Charters, LLC, Lincoln, in Application No. B-1841 should be cancelled.
