By Show Cause Order entered May 13, 2014, this Commission ordered Tyson Hinrichsen Enterprises dba Shorty's Party Bus Services, Grand Island, Nebraska, to demonstrate why its application should not be dismissed. A hearing on the matter was held on May 28, 2014, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. Mr. Hinrichsen did not enter a personal appearance at the hearing. Mark Breiner appeared on behalf of the Commission staff.

Shorty's Party Bus Services did not comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission, to wit: No Form E insurance was filed and no annual fees have been paid as of this date.

Several attempts were made to contact the Applicant with no success.
