## OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed October 6, 2016, Benstrans ("Applicant"), Loveland, Colorado, informed the Commission that it wished to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1855 on February 20, 2009. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by van between points in Dawes, Box Butte, Sheridan and Sioux counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews was not authorized, and HHS designation was yes.

Notice of this application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 10, 2016. No protests were filed.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Benstrans, Loveland, Colorado, in Application No. B-1855 should be cancelled.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of Benstrans is hereby granted and the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in B-1855 is hereby cancelled.
