BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 16, 2014, an application was filed by Russ Bus ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by special party and charter bus between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized. The application was granted on April 1, 2014; however, Applicant never finalized its approval by filing the required insurance with the Commission.

The Commission has attempted to contact Applicant by mail and telephone regarding the application and the missing insurance information. On November 1, 2016, the Commission entered an order of pending dismissal requiring Applicant to take action on its application by November 14, 2016, or the application would be dismissed. To date, Applicant has not contacted the Commission nor complied with the requirement to file its insurance information.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Application No. B-1866 for Russ Bus, Omaha, should be dismissed for failure to take timely action.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1866 be, and is hereby, dismissed.


