OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed January 20, 2017, Good Times Roll ("Applicant"), Omaha, informed the Commission that it wished to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1869 on December 2, 2014. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers in charter service by van between points in Douglas County and between points in Lancaster County and between points in said counties. The transportation of railroad train crews was not authorized, and HHS designation was no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on January 24, 2017. No protests were filed.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Good times Roll, Omaha, in Application No. B-1869 should be cancelled.
