OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 28, 2017, KC Cruisers, ("Applicant"), Lodgepole, informed the Commission that it wished to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1875 on December 2, 2014. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 3, 2017. No protests were filed.
