BY THE COMMISSION:

By show cause order entered August 4, 2015, this Commission ordered A 2 Z Transportation Services, Omaha, Nebraska, to demonstrate why its certificate of public convenience and necessity should not be revoked. A hearing on the matter was held on August 25, 2015, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. No one from A 2 Z Transportation Services made a personal appearance at the hearing. Mark Breiner appeared on behalf of the Commission staff.

As of September 1, 2015, the Applicant, A 2 Z Transportation Services, is not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit, no Form E insurance filing has been made, no rates have been filed with the Commission, and no annual fees have been paid.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission the Order To Show Cause is sustained, and that the authority granted to A 2 Z Transportation Services, Omaha, Nebraska, in B-1881, shall be, and it is hereby, revoked.
