OPINION AND FINDINGS

On February 24, 2015, the Commission entered an order granting a suspension of authority for Opulence Limousine, Inc. ("Opulence"), Lincoln, for one year. The suspension ended February 23, 2016.

On September 28, 2016, the motor transportation department notified Opulence that its suspension was up and action must be taken. Department staff has attempted to work with Opulence to return to compliance. Opulence has failed to take the appropriate actions and has ceased communicating with the Department. Opulence does not have valid insurance in place.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that Opulence Limousine, Inc., Lincoln, should be ordered to show cause as to why its Certificate should not be revoked for failure to maintain proper insurance and take action following suspension. Therefore, hearing on this matter shall be held on Tuesday, October 10, 2018, at 11:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
