BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 12, 2017, Ambassador Transportation, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by removing a restriction that requires Applicant to use only vans in the provision of its transportation services in Douglas County. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 20, 2017. The application was timely protested by Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc. (collectively, "Protestants").

A planning Conference was held February 27, 2018. Subsequent to the planning conference, Protestants Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc. moved to withdraw their protests. The motion to withdraw protests was granted on May 3, 2018. The Application was then processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the Commission Rules of Procedure.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that the Application filed by Ambassador Transportation, LLC to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be amended. The restrictive language regarding specific vehicles contained in Certificate B-1886 should be stricken and replaced with the following:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers in open class service between points in Douglas County. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.
