OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed June 10, 2016, Shiloh Place, LLC ("Applicant"), Fremont, seeks a supplement to its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to extend their authority as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicle as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by van in open class service between points in Dodge County, and between said points in Dodge County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: To be limited to the participants/clients of Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

The current certificate will be revoked upon granting of Supplement 1.

Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on June 20, 2016. A timely protest was filed on June 30, 2016 by Golden Plains Transportation ("GPS"). GPS withdrew its protest on July 14, 2016. The application was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the Commission Rules of Procedure.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed service, and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-301 to 75-322 (Supp. 2015), and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.
- 2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the following extent:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage by van in open class service between points in Dodge County, and between said points in Dodge County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: To be limited to the participants/clients of Shiloh Center Adult Day Services. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: Yes.

3. The application for authority should be granted as amended.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1888, Supplement 2 be, and it is hereby, granted as amended; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, Supplement 1, shall be issued to Shiloh Place, LLC, Fremont, in Application B-1888.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with NEB. REV. STAT. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Supp. 2015), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.
