OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed February 3, 2016, Heartland Van, LLC (Heartland Van), Vermillion, South Dakota, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1890 on June 8, 2015. The Commission granted Heartland Van the authority to provide transportation of wheelchair clients by van in Dakota, Dixon, Thurston and Wayne counties, and the transportation of wheelchair and ambulatory clients in Cedar and Knox Counties. Heartland Van was granted a HHS designation. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 5, 2016. No protests were filed, therefore this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Heartland Van, LLC, Vermillion, South Dakota, in Application No. B-1890 should be cancelled.
