OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed March 17, 2016, Seward Limo, LLC ("Seward Limo"), Seward, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Application No. B-1891 on February 17, 2015. The Commission granted Seward Limo the authority to provide transportation of passengers by bus within the State of Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad crews and their baggage was not authorized, and the HHS designation was no.

Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 21, 2016. No protests were filed; therefore, this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and the authority granted to Seward Limo, LLC, Seward, Nebraska, in Application No. B-1891 should be cancelled.
