By application filed September 22, 2015, 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care (Applicant), Omaha, seeks to change an existing operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

Notice of the application was published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 25, 2015, pursuant to the rules of the Commission.

Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-1892 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of Commission Rules of Procedure.

4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care is an LLC duly organized and existing under and by the virtue of the laws of the State of Nebraska, with its principal place of business being in Omaha, Nebraska. The business headquarters of 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care LLC, will remain in its current location in Omaha, Nebraska, if the transfer of the stock of 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care, Omaha, Nebraska, is approved by the Commission. Applicant is in the business of providing transportation of passengers by van. Applicant currently provides services between points in Douglas and Sarpy counties over irregular routes. Applicant will continue to provide the same service.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the proposed extended service.
2. The proposed change of control will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.

3. The certificate issued in Application No. B-1892 is not dormant.
4. An order should be entered in Application No. B-1892 authorizing 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care, Omaha, to change operation by the transfer of stock ownership.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1892 be, and it is hereby, granted; and that 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care, Omaha, is hereby authorized to change its existing operation through the transfer of stock ownership as follows: current ownership, Scott Underwood (85%) and Shane Underwood (15%); proposed ownership, Tim Hagerty (75%) and Carol Johnson (25%).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operations authorized herein shall be subject to the terms, conditions and limitations which have been or may hereafter be prescribed by the Commission.
