Applicant operates as an open class carrier with a certificate of public convenience and necessity under Certificate No. B-1892. In its application, Applicant seeks an order from the Commission approving a name change to Remington Patient Care.

Upon consideration of Applicant's filing and the files and records of the Commission relative to Applicant and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant has changed its name, but no other aspect of the organization of Applicant has changed.
- 2. The authority held by Applicant should be carried in the files of the Commission in the new name of the Applicant to wit: Remington Patient Care, Omaha, Nebraska.
- 3. No further action or relief should be granted pursuant to Applicant's notification and request for official recognition of its new name.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the application of 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care to change its name is hereby approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority held by Applicant under the name of 4 Pax LLC d/b/a Caliber Patient Care pursuant to Certificate No. B-1892 shall be, and it is hereby, held by Applicant under the new name of Remington Patient Care.
