By application filed February 8, 2018, Remington Patient Care ("Applicant"), Papillion, seeks to cancel its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued by the Commission in Docket No. B-1892 on April 4, 2017. The Commission granted Applicant the authority to provide transportation of passengers by van in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews is not allowed and HHS designation is no. Notice of this application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 12, 2018. No protests were filed; therefore, this application shall be processed in accordance with the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.





O R D E R



