OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 16, 2015, an application was filed by The "O" Party Bus, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking to acquire, through transfer, the authority granted to Opulence Limousine, Inc. ("Opulence"), Lincoln, in Certificate No. B-1883. The application was not protested. By letter dated May 1, 2015, Applicant was notified that the application would be processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure. Applicant did not complete the application process, and a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity was not issued.

On October 5, 2016, Applicant notified the Commission that it wished to dismiss its application. Notice of this request was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 7, 2016.

Upon due consideration of this request, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the request should be granted and Application No. B-1900 should be dismissed.
