## BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 8, 2015, an application was filed by DJB Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Midwest Mobility (Applicant), Lincoln, seeking authority as a common carrier of passengers by bus between points in Lancaster County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and Applicant is not seeking HHS designation. Notice of the application was published in <a href="The Daily Record">The Daily Record</a>, Omaha, on July 27, 2015. No protests were filed.

By letter dated August 31, 2015, the Commission informed Applicant that supporting affidavits must be filed with the Commission no later than September 14, 2015, or the application would be dismissed. On February 2, 2016, the Commission entered an order notifying Applicant of the pending dismissal of its application if the required affidavits were not received by February 16, 2016. As of the date of this Order, the Commission has not received the required affidavits and written communication from the Commission was returned as undeliverable.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Application No. B-1911 for DJB Enterprises, LLC, d/b/a Midwest Mobility should be dismissed for failure to take timely action.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1911 be, and is hereby, dismissed.
