OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 5, 2015, an application was filed by Galaxy Shuttle Party Bus ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is no.

On February 22, 2017, the Application was granted. However, Applicant did not complete the necessary steps to finalize his certificate, namely providing proof of the required insurance. The Motor Transportation Department staff attempted to contact Applicant many times. Applicant indicated he was having difficulty obtaining the necessary insurance. On July 20, 2017, Applicant notified Department staff he wished to dismiss his application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. The motion should be granted.
- 2. Application No. B-1919 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1919 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
