BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On November 2, 2015, Premier Limousine, LLC (Applicant), Broken Bow, filed an application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier of passengers by bus and limousine between all points in Nebraska. Timely protests were filed on November 23, 2015 by Destinations d/b/a Chauffeured Services, LLC (Destinations), and on December 1, 2015 by Night Life Limousine, LLC.

On December 6, 2015, Applicant amended its application to restrict its geographic area to points originating in Custer, Dawson, Sherman, Valley, Blaine, Thomas and Logan Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. On January 11, 2016, Night Life Limousine withdrew their protest to the Application.

On January 11, 2016, a telephonic planning conference was held before Commissioner Gerald Vap to discuss a procedural schedule and hearing dates. Mr. Mark Breiner and Ms. Jamie Reyes represented the Commission, and the following persons

As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket. The Hearing Officer finds that the following schedule should be adopted:
