BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 21, 2015, an application was filed by AC Care, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van between points in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy counties, and between points in said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, on March 10, 2016. On April 13, 2016, a Hearing Officer Order was entered to grant the protests of Golden Plains Services Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation; Camelot Transportation Inc.; Triumph Transportation, Inc.; and Transport Plus of Lincoln, Inc.

The Commission has attempted to contact Applicant by email and telephone regarding the pending application. Applicant has not contacted the Commission. On June 28, 2016, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal requiring Applicant to take action on its application by July 15, 2016 or the application would be dismissed. The Commission has not received any communication from Applicant.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that Application B-1924 for AC Care, LLC, Omaha, should be dismissed for failure to take timely action.
