BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 14, 2016, an application was filed by Fly Rydes Transport, LLC ("Applicant"), Scottsbluff, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van between points in Scotts Bluff County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is no.

On September 27, 2016, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal due to Applicant's missing background check information from the Nebraska State Patrol. Subsequent to the order, Applicant submitted the requested information.

Since that time, Commission staff have attempted to contact Applicant by email and telephone regarding the pending application. Applicant has not contacted the Commission in order to progress the Application forward.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that a deadline for action to be taken by Applicant in this docket should be set. If the Commission does not receive any communication or direction from Applicant concerning this application by **July 7, 2017**, the Commission will dismiss the application for failure to take timely action.
