O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On June 14, 2016, an application was filed by Fly Rydes Transport, LLC ("Applicant"), Scottsbluff, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van between points in Scotts Bluff County, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is no.

On September 27, 2016, the Commission entered an Order of Pending Dismissal due to Applicant's missing background check information from the Nebraska State Patrol. Subsequent to the order, Applicant submitted the requested information.

Since that time, Commission staff have attempted to contact Applicant by email and telephone regarding the pending application. Applicant has not contacted the Commission in order to progress the Application forward.

On June 22, 2017, the Commission entered an order of Pending Dismissal. The applicant was given a deadline of July 7, 2017 to make contact with the Commission to discuss progressing the application. The Applicant has made no such contact to date.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. The motion should be granted.
2. Application No. B-1932, should be dismissed.
