O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On September 6, 2017, an application was filed by Aliyha Tap ("Applicant"), Lincoln, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by SUV in open class service between points in Lancaster and Douglas Counties on the one hand, and, points in the State of Nebraska over irregular routes on the other hand. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, on September 12, 2016.

Timely protests were received from Transport Plus of Lincoln, Inc.; Golden Plains Services, Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation; Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc.; and Checker Cab, Happy Cab, Yellow Cab, Cornhusker Cab, and Safeway Cab (Collectively Omaha Cab Companies). All Protestants had withdrawn their protests except Camelot Transportation, Triumph Transportation, and the Omaha Cab Companies.

Hearing was scheduled on this matter for November 8, 2017. On November 1, 2017, Applicant submitted a request to withdraw her application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the motion should be granted and Application No. B-1938 should be dismissed.
