OPINION AND FINDINGS

By Application filed November 2, 2016, Good Times Limousine, Inc. ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks to acquire, through transfer, the operating rights granted to Good Times Limousine, Inc. ("Good Times"), Omaha, in Certificate B-1906. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, on November 22, 2016. Because no protests were filed, Application No. B-1944 was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the Commission Rules of Procedure.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

- 1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able to properly perform the proposed extended service.
- 2. The proposed transfer of operating rights will be consistent with the public interest and will not unduly restrict competition.
- 3. The certificate issued in Certificate B-1906 is not dormant.
- 4. A certificate should be issued in Application No. B-1944 authorizing the following operations:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTIONS: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1944 be, and is hereby, granted; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to Good Times Limousine, Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, in Application No. B-1944, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings; and that to avoid a lapse of authority, the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued in Certificate B-1906 shall be cancelled simultaneously with the issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application No. B-1944.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity authorized by the Commission unless and until Applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 75-305 (fees), 75-307 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates) (Supp. 2015) and with the Rules and Regulations of the Commission, and if upon expiration of such time Applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this Order shall, after reasonable notice to Applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall not conduct operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience Necessity is issued.
