BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On January 19, 2017, Lift Medical Transportation ("Applicant"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority as a common carrier to transport passengers in open class by van in Douglas, Sarpy, Cass, Lancaster, and Washington Counties. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska on January 24, 2017.

The following protests were filed: Camelot Transportation, Inc. and Triumph Transportation, Inc. on January 27, 2017; Golden Plains Services, Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation on January 30, 2017; and Transport Plus of Lincoln, Inc. on February 23, 2017.

After due consideration, I find that the protests filed by Camelot Transportation, Inc., Triumph Transportation, Inc., Golden Plains Services, Inc. d/b/a GPS Transportation, and Transport Plus of Lincoln, Inc. should be granted.

## O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that the above-mentioned protests shall be granted.
