O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed March 9, 2017, Black Diamond S&S ("Applicant"), Scottsbluff, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Blue Collar Limo Service, Bayard, in Certificate B-1838 which authorizes:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers by limousine in Morrill, Scotts Bluff, Banner, Kimball, Cheyenne, Garden, Box Butte, Sheridan, and Sioux Counties, and between points within such counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.

In its Application, Applicant requested that the Commission grant temporary approval to the Applicant of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by it. Notice of the temporary authority request was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on March 16, 2017 pursuant to the rules and regulations of this Commission.

It appears that failure to grant temporary approval may result in destruction of or injury to such motor carrier property and the certificate sought to be acquired, or interfere substantially with their future usefulness in the performance of adequate and continuous service to the public.

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. § 75-319.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Black Diamond S&S, LLC, Scottsbluff, will, and it is hereby, granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-311 and to the rules and regulations of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
