OPINION AND FINDINGS

On March 22, 2017, an application was filed by Transition-n-More ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van in open class service between points in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, on the one hand, and on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is yes.

The Application was granted as amended on May 1, 2018. Applicant was provided with necessary information on how to complete the process to obtain the Certificate; however, Applicant failed to complete those steps. On December 27, 2018, Applicant contacted the Commission to indicate she has been unable to obtain the necessary insurance and wished to dismiss her application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds Applicant's request should be granted. Therefore, Application B-1952 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1952 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
