O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 1, 2017, an application was filed by Three Sons Inc. ("Applicant"), Malcolm, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by bus in special party and charter service in Butler, Cass, Gage, Lancaster, Saunders, and Seward Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is no.

The Application was granted on July 11, 2017. Applicant was provided with necessary information on how to complete the process to obtain the Certificate; however, Applicant was unable to obtain the necessary insurance. On October 3, 2017, Applicant contacted the Motor Transportation Department to indicate they wished to withdraw the application.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. The motion should be granted.
2. Application No. B-1955 should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application B-1955 be, and it is hereby, dismissed.
