OPINION AND FINDINGS

On May 31, 2017, an application was filed by Omaha Senior Medical Transportation Services, Inc.("Applicant"), Omaha, seeking authority as a common carrier in Nebraska intrastate commerce in the transportation of passengers by van and handicap van between points in Douglas and Sarpy Counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes.
