O P I N I O N   A N D   F I N D I N G S

On March 6, 2018, the Commission entered an order granting the application of CASHCAA, LLC, d/b/a 4 County Party Bus (4 County), Broken Bow, Nebraska, to provide transportation services as a common carrier by bus in special party and charter service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. The Order included the steps that must be taken by 4 County in order to be issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, including payment of fees, registering vehicles, proof of insurance, and filing rates.

Applicant was provided with the necessary information to complete the process to obtain the Certificate; however, Applicant failed to complete those steps. On August 28, 2018, the Commission entered an order of pending dismissal. 4 County had until September 18 to take action on this application. 4 County contacted the Commission on September 17, 2018, requesting an extension of time to obtain proper insurance. The Commission entered an order granting an extension until November 1, 2018. The Order noted that failure to take action would result in dismissal of the Application. To date, 4 County has failed to take action and provide proof of proper insurance to the Commission.

After due consideration and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds Applicant has failed to complete the necessary steps to obtain a certificate. Therefore, Application B-1964 should be dismissed.


