BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 21, 2018, WHC NE, LLC, d/b/a zTrip Airport Transportation ("zTrip"), Omaha, filed an application seeking authority to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity by adding minibus to its current vehicle restriction in its open class authority. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on December 21, 2018. No Frotests were filed; therefore, the Application was processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the Commission Rules of Procedure.

Based on the above, the Commission finds that the Application filed by zTrip to amend its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should be granted. The language contained in Part B of Certificate B-1969 should be stricken and replaced with the following:

CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED:

Part B. Common: Transportation of passengers and their baggage by van and minibus between points in Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy Counties, and between said counties, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their luggage is not allowed. HHS Designation: yes.

All other parts of Certificate B-1969 should remain unchanged.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1969 be, and is hereby,
