By application filed November 26, 2018, Ambassador Transportation, LLC ("Applicant"), Omaha, seeks approval of the acquisition of the operating rights and authority granted to Ambassador Transportation, LLC, Omaha, in Certificate B-1886, which authorizes:

Such temporary approval should be granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-319.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Application for approval of a lease of the motor carrier properties and the certificate sought to be acquired by Ambassador Transportation, LLC, Omaha, be, and is hereby,

granted for ninety (90) days from the effective date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that transportation service rendered under such temporary authority shall be subject to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-311 and to the rules and regulations of the Commission; such grant of temporary authority shall not be admissible in evidence to establish or prove present or future public convenience and necessity; and no renewal or extension of the period of ninety (90) days shall be granted.
