## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On October 4, 2000, Transport Plus, Inc., Lincoln, Nebraska filed an application for authority to amend its van rates as follows:

Notice of the application was published in <u>The Daily Record</u>, Omaha, Nebraska, on October 9, 2000, pursuant to the Commission's rules. the application is unprotested.

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Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1439. The certificate authorizes the transportation (a) retired and semi-retired persons 60 years old and older requiring specialized personal assistance, children 16 years old and Younger requiring specialized personal assistance, and visually-impaired persons requiring specialized personal assistance between points in Lancaster county over irregular routes; (b) passengers requiring specialized personal assistance and their baggage from points in Lancaster county, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular routes; and (c) members of church and youth groups from points in Lancaster county, on the one hand, and, on the other hand, points in Nebraska over irregular Supplement 1, to its authority, authorizes the transportation of passengers that are ADA eligible between points in Lancaster county and from points originating in Lancaster county to points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: Restricted against taxi service; 24 -hour advance scheduling is required for all transportation other than transportation conducted under contract with the Lincoln Star Tran Brokerage Program. Other restrictions apply.

Applicant states that it has made a concerted effort to maintain its current rates. However, increases in operational expenses (i.e. fuel, vehicle maintenance, wages and insurance) have necessitated a review of these rates and a request for an increase. Wage increases are necessary to retain quality personnel. Insurance costs continue to escalate at the rate of 5% per annum. Vehicle maintenance costs have also increased approximately 4% within the past year. The rates proposed are deemed to be competitive and compensatory.

Applicant's current rates were established two years ago. The proposed rates represent an average increase of approximately 5.2%. In the same two year period, the consumer price index has increased approximately 7%. Over the past two years, fuel costs have risen 40% and vehicle maintenance costs have increased 8%. The proposed rates are comparable to rates on file for other carriers providing similar type services.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted effective December 22, 2000.

## ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective December 22, 2000, Transport Plus, Inc., Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its van rates as follows: APPLICATION NO. BR-258
