OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 8, 2006, R & F Hobbies, Inc., dba Prince of the Road, Ravenna, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend its non-charter individual passenger service rates as follows:

In support of its application, the Applicant represents to the Commission that it has been somewhat over three years since its last rate application. During this time, fuel and other expenses, especially insurance, makes the rate increase necessary.

The rates proposed represent an increase of 4% in the three areas proposed. No other changes to the rates are being proposed other than those set forth above. These rates were last increased in April of 2005.

The rural mileage rate would rise to \$1.26 per mile. This is set at the State of Nebraska Health and Human Services rates that became effective November 1, 2006.

In order to grant an application on an emergency basis, the applicant must show and the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. The applicant represents to the Commission that it will be at a competitive disadvantage with regards to its Health and Human Services clients if the rate is not approved in light of the rate being raised by the Department of Health and Human Services to \$1.26 per mile effective November 1, 2006.

The Commission does find that the rural rates should be approved on an emergency basis due to the fact that the applicant will be at a disadvantage with regards to the Department of Health and Human Services if the rate increase is not granted. The Commission also finds that the proposed rates for the other parts of the application are reasonable and competitive and should be approved in this order.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 27, 2006.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service commission that R & R Hobbies, Inc., dba Prince of the Road, Ravenna, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to amend its non-charter individual passenger service rates on an emergency basis effective November 27, 2006, as per the attached rate schedule which by reference hereto becomes a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that public notice of this action be published in the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, pursuant to the provisions of Section 75-121, R.R.S. 2003, and the Commission rules.
