OPINION AND FINDINGS

On August 16, 2007, Yellow Cab & Limo, Inc., Beatrice, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed Rates</u>
Open Class Service in area	\$140.00 round trip or \$25.00 per person whichever is greater

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1434, Supplement 6. The certificate supplement authorizes the transportation of passengers and their baggage in open class service as a contract carrier for Advanced Services, Beatrice, by vans between points in Gage County and Lancaster County, and between points in said counties

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1434, Supplement 6 on July 24, 2007. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective September 20, 2007.
