Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Permit B-1707. The permit authorizes the transportation of clients of Orr Psychotherapy Resources and their baggage between points within thirty miles of current Orr Psychotherapy Resources offices in Lancaster and Seward Counties in open class service by van over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Permit No. B-1707 on January 29, 2008. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rate is based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums and other overhead charges.
