On October 30, 2008, Trease Enterprises, Inc., dba Special Moments Limousine, Clearwater, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

cents per mile for every10 cent increase in the price of diesel #2.

Emergency action is requested.

Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1711. The certificate allows the transportation of passengers and their baggage by bus in charter and special party service between all points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate No. B-1711 on February 26, 2008. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rate is based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective November 8, 2008.
