OPININON AND FINDINGS

On July 6, 2010, Red9, LLC, dba Red 9, Lincoln, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
Bus Rate	\$85/hour

Applicant is a certificated contract carrier which holds Permit Number B-1765. The certificate authorizes the Transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party service between points in Lancaster, Seward, Saline, Gage, Johnson, Otoe, Cass, butler, Sarpy, Saunders, Douglas, Dodge, Washington, York, and Jefferson. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

Emergency action is requested.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1765 on July 13, 2010. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate.

The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed amended rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges. The rates are competitive with similar rates charges by other services for these types of vehicles.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin

operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective July 14, 2010.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective July 14, 2010, Red9, LLC, dba Red 9, Lincoln, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:

Bus Rate	\$85/hour
