On March 1, 2012, TAA, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Applicant is a certificated common carrier which holds Certificate B-1806, Supplement 1, which reads as follows:

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: Transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1806, Supplement 1 on March 6, 2012. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

The Commission finds that the rates as proposed are reasonable and should be approved. The rates are competitive and reasonable when compared to similar companies providing a similar service.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this

application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under this Supplement until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the Application on an emergency basis.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted on an emergency basis effective March 9, 2012.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective March 9, 2012, TAA, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
