BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 5, 2012, Grand Island Party Bus, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to establish rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Wedding Parties will have a \$150.00 minimum charge

Emergency action is requested.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1810. The certificate authorizes transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party between points in Hall County, and between points in Hall County on the one hand and, on the other hand, points within a 150 mile radius of Grand Island over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is No.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1810 on November 19, 2012. The Applicant is establishing its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon anticipated expenses in vehicle maintenance, fuel expenses, insurance premiums, advertising and other overhead charges.

In applications such as these, the Commission must find that an emergency situation exists. Such a situation exists in this application as the Applicant cannot begin operations under its certificate as granted until the rates are approved. Therefore, the Commission finds that an emergency basis exists that allows the Commission to grant the Application on an emergency basis.

The Commission further finds that the proposed rates are reasonable.
