## BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 12, 2013, Grand Island Party Bus, LLC, Grand Island, Nebraska, filed an application for authority to amend rates for its use in its operations as follows:

Wedding Parties will have a \$300.00 minimum charge

The Application was published in the  $\underline{\text{Daily Record}}$  on February 15, 2013. No protests to the application were received.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant is a certificated carrier which holds Certificate Number B-1810. The certificate authorizes transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party between points in Hall County, and between points in Hall County on the one hand and, on the other hand, points within a 150 mile radius of Grand Island over irregular routes. The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized, and the HHS Designation is No.

The Applicant received authority to operate from the Commission under Certificate Number B-1810 on November 19, 2012. The Applicant is amending its rates for use in this certificate. The Applicant represents to the Commission that the proposed rates are based upon a new bus being placed into service. This bus is larger than the previous bus used by the Applicant. The capacity of the bus is larger.

The Applicant has paid more for the new bus, and expenses such as insurance, maintenance and gasoline will also be increased. The proposed rates are based upon anticipated expense increase in these items.

The Commission finds that the proposed rates are reasonable. The Commission further finds that the proposed rates are competitive with rates charged by similar situated companies providing a similar service.

Upon consideration of the application and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be granted May 17, 2013.

ORDER

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that effective May 17, 2013, Grand Island Party Bus, Grand Island, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby, authorized to establish rates for its use as follows:
